NSORO Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

- Currently in foster care,a
 ward of the state, and
 eligible for ILP, or have aged
 out of foster care
- High school graduate (or equivalent) with a minimum of 2.0 GPA
- Accepted into an accredited,
 Pell eligible college or post
 secondary school
- Under 26 years old at the time of application (if not previously funded by NSORO)
- U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident

Scholarship Guidelines

- Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA to remain eligible.
- Scholarships
 are awarded
 annually on May
 15, with
 notifications sent
 via email.
- Funds may cover tuition, books, room & board, transportation, and food (sent directly to the institution).

Required Documents

- Three letters of recommendation (from teachers, employers, or community leaders).
- Official transcript (must include registrar's name & contact info).
- Proof of foster care status (court document or letter from caseworker/ILS).
