Deadlines: Open youth in OASIS enter by **July 1, 2025**. Closed Cases – enter by September 15, 2025. Please use the next 5 months to diligently search and locate each youth.

SURVEYS CAN (AND SHOULD) BE ENTERED PRIOR TO THE YOUTH'S 19th BIRTHDAY.

#### LSA & TPs Broadcast.

Compliance rates for Federally required Life Skills Assessments and Transitions Plans are low. <u>Best Practice Tips:</u>

- ✓ Obtain copies of Life Skill Assessments (LSA) from providers along with first monthly report.
- ✓Update transition plan more than once a year.
- ✓ Coordinate Transition Plan (TP) meeting in conjunction with other scheduled meetings such as Family Partnership Meetings, FAPT, ect.

#### **Free Tuition / No Loans**

If you have a youth attending a Virginia *public* 4-year college or university, please ensure they are accessing the tuition, fees, and room & board coverage available under **VA Code § 23.1-601**.

Contact <u>financial aid offices</u> to confirm the youth has **not accepted student loans** to cover tuition or fees for the **2025–2026 academic year**.

If any loans were accepted, have the youth return the funds immediately. Then, notify Brooke Newman, ETV Program Specialist, at **brooke.newman@dss.virginia.gov** with the youth's name and school.

Let's work together to make sure our youth maximize their financial resources and avoid unnecessary debt!

Reminder, Fiscal Year 2025 **Chafee**, **ETV**, **Drive To Thrive** and **Housing Support Program** funds need to be used prior to May 31st. **Please** speak with your finance department to coordinate the last day your LDSS is able to submit funding requests/case actions for BL 862 and BL 861.

Any Drive To Thrive Funds (BL 877) and Housing Support Funds not used by May 31<sup>st</sup> will require a request form to be resubmitted.
